WHO	You are eligible for the PGWP if you: - Completed an NBCC program that was at least 8 months in length and led to a diploma or certificate, - Maintained full-time status during each semester of your program (some exceptions apply; see link), - Provide proof of language test results with a minimum score of CLB 5 in all four categories, and - Meet (or be exempt from) the field of study requirements. You can only receive a PGWP once in your life.	Work in Canada after you graduate: Who can apply - Canada.ca

WHERE	Apply online from inside or outside Canada. There are considerations associated with applying from outside of Canada (including work authorizations while waiting for a decision, ability to enter Canada, etc.).	My immigration or citizenship application - Canada.ca
